1.0 Introduction

This annual publication, the thirteenth in a series, reports on the state of tertiary education enrolment in Mauritius, as at December, 2011. It follows the same pattern as the previous editions and focuses on student enrolment from three broad sources, namely publicly-funded institutions, private and overseas.

2.0 Data Collection and Methodology

The Report covers enrolment in the eleven Publicly-Funded Institutions (PFIs), namely the University of Mauritius (UoM), the University of Technology, Mauritius (UTM), the Mauritius Institute of Education (MIE), the Mahatma Gandhi Institute (MGI), the Mauritius College of the Air (MCA), the Swami Dayanand Institute of Management (SDIM), the Institut Supérieur de Technologie (IST), the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development (MITD), the Mauritius Institute of Health (MIH), the Rabindranath Tagore Institute (RTI) and the Fashion and Design Institute (FDI).

A comprehensive coverage of enrolment from private sources is also provided. In this regard, all the 59 institutions registered with TEC were surveyed on their enrolment status as at December 2011: 13 were not in operation while 3 were in the process of launching their programmes; 41 institutions, on the other hand, participated in the exercise, representing an effective response rate of 95%. Statistics were, in parallel, collected from examinations centres locally, including the Mauritius Examinations Syndicate (MES) and 28 other examination centres, classified as “Non-MES Sources”. These examination centres organized examinations in respect of 67 overseas awarding bodies in 2011. The examination statistics which covered both students attending private institutions as well as those studying through the e-learning/distance education mode locally enable a good estimate of enrolment in respect of the latter to be made.

With a view to give a full picture of the participation of Mauritian students in tertiary education, statistics were also compiled on Mauritian students studying overseas as well as foreign students studying locally. Foreign embassies and High Commissions based in Mauritius, namely the French Embassy through *Campus France*, the Australian Embassy, the British High Commission, the Chinese Embassy, the High Commission of India, the High Commission of

Pakistan, the Russian Embassy and the US Embassy, amongst others, were contacted to gauge the number of student visas issued to Mauritian students by field. Secondary sources of information from the Employees Welfare Fund, the Scholarship Section of the Ministry of Education & Human Resources and private recruiting agents as well as international students' databases were also tapped.

3.0 Overall Participation 2011

The tertiary student population increased by 1,635, from 44,334 in December 2010 to 45,969 in December 2011, representing an enrolment growth of 3.7% for the year. The Gross Tertiary Enrolment Rate¹ (GTER), in contrast, stalled at the 45% mark, more or less equivalent to the previous year's figure of 45.1% (Figure 1); owing to a relative increase in the population base used for computing the indicator, from 97,031 in 2010 to 100,769 in 2011.

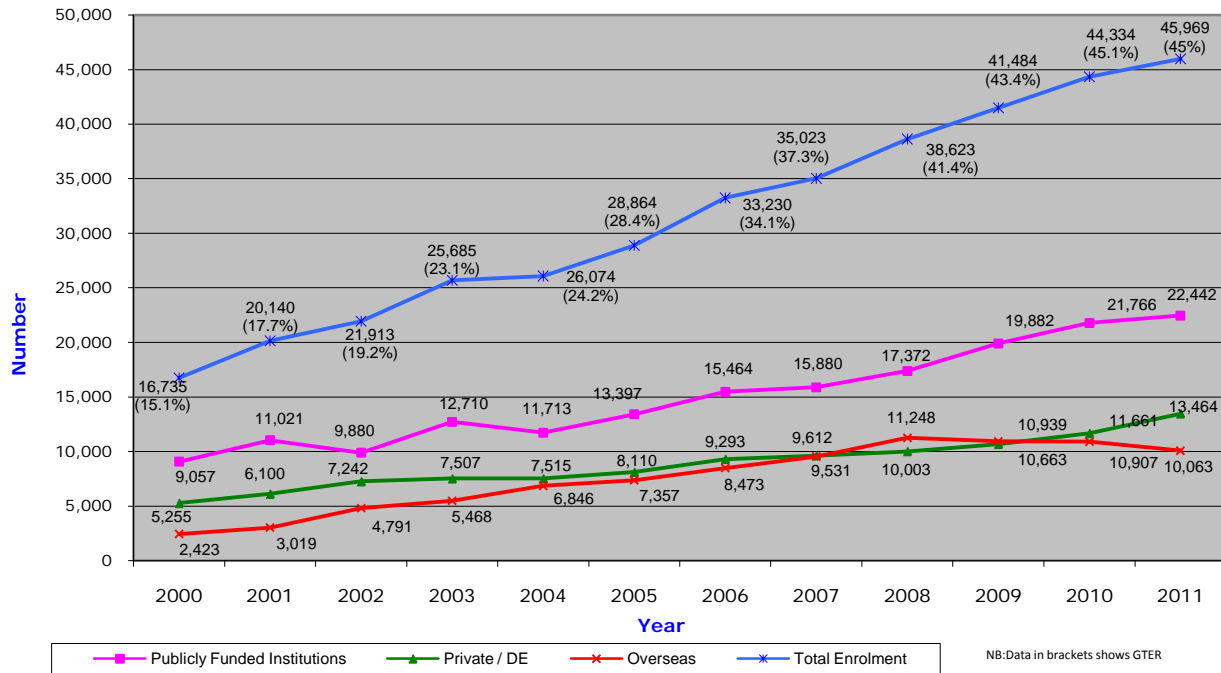
The distribution of total tertiary education enrolment by source and field of study is shown at Table 1. Administration/Management remained the most popular discipline accounting for an enrolment of 7,397 (16.1% of the total), followed by Accounting- 6,009 (13.1%), Education- 4,171 (9.1%), Information Technology-3,878 (8.4%), Engineering- 3,742 (8.1%), Business/Commerce/Marketing- 2,283 (5.0%), Medicine- 2,124 (4.6%), Banking/Finance- 2,115 (4.6%), Law- 1,796 (3.9%), Languages- 1,519 (3.3%), Travel/Hotel/Tourism- 1,384 (3.0%), Social Science- 1,132 (2.5%) and Science - 990 (2.2 %).

Science & Technology related subjects which had lost ground since 2007 reversed steam for the second year in succession, increasing their share in total enrolment from 28 % in 2009 to 29% in 2010 and 29.7% in 2011. An improvement was registered with regard to enrolment in Health Sciences (+21.3% from 755 to 916), Architecture (+18.8% from 276 to 326), Medicine (+10.7% from 1919 to 2124), Mathematics (+9.1% from 649 to 708) and Science (+4.2% from 950 to 990); while a decline was registered in Dentistry (-20.5%; from 219 to 174) and Textile (-9.7%, from 268 to 242).

The evolution of enrolment by source over the period 2000-2011 is depicted in Figure 1 while Figure 2 gives the change occurring in the distribution of enrolment between 2010 and 2011, by source, with emphasis on the PFIs.

4.0 Tertiary Enrolment Distribution in 2011

A total of 35,906 students (78%) were pursuing their higher studies locally: 22,442 (48.8%) attended the PFIs and 13,464 (29.3%) were registered with a private institution or enrolled directly with an institution overseas through the distance education mode (Table1). Some 10,063 students (21.9%), on the other hand, were studying overseas.

The distribution of tertiary enrolment by source and mode of study is shown in the Table below. Overall, an estimated 58.6% (26,935) of students were studying full-time, 27% (12,398) part-time and 14.4% (6,636) through the distance education mode.

Within the PFIs, 58.8% of students were female (Table 4), 58.1% (13,032) were studying on a full-time basis, 32% (7,196) on a part-time basis and 9.9% (2,214) through the distance

education mode. The majority of students (60.2% or 13,506) were reading for a Degree (including diploma/degree), 19.9% (4,469) for a Diploma and 5.3% (1,188) for a Certificate, while 10.1% (2,275) were doing a Masters, 2.5% a Postgraduate Diploma/Certificate, 0.9% either a PhD (56) or an MPhil (139) and 1.1% (248) a Foundation or equivalent programme (Table 5).

Estimated Enrolment Distribution by Source and Mode, 2011

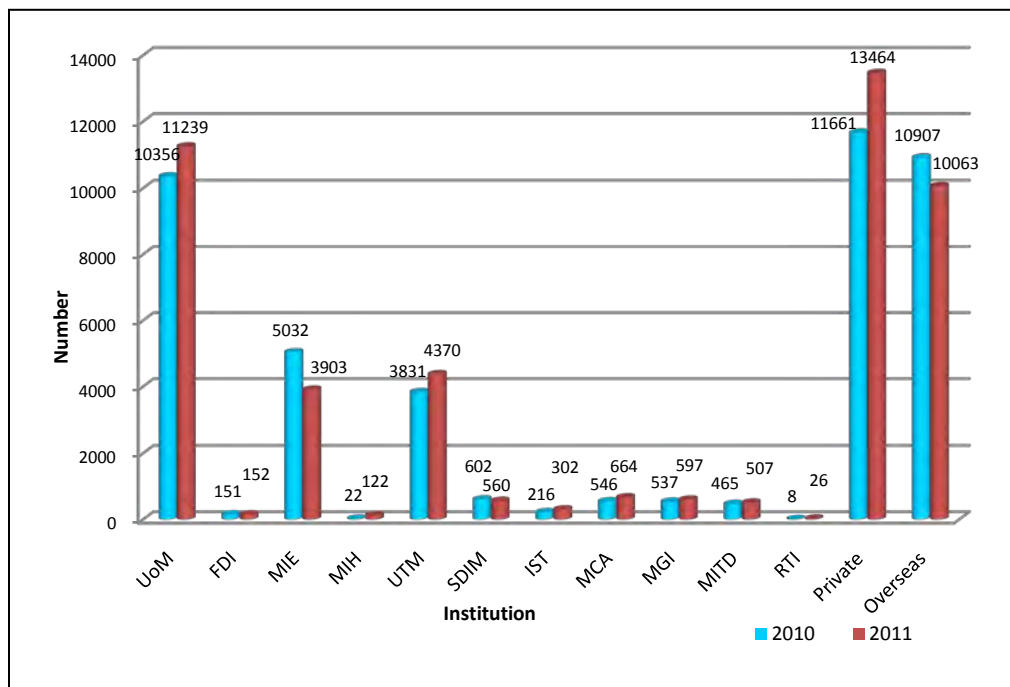

Tables 6 and 7 give the distribution of enrolment in the PFIs by gender and level as well as by mode of study respectively. On the whole, female outnumbered male students by some 3,962 representing 58.8% (13,202) of students in 2011 compared to 56.8% (12,358) in 2010. Some 56.5% of female students were enrolled full-time, 32% part-time and 11.5% through the DE mode as opposed to 60.3%, 32.2% and 7.5% respectively for male students. Male students predominated in 4 institutions, namely the UTM, RTI, IST and the MITD.

New intake at the tertiary level declined by 6.5%, from 18,126 in 2010 to 16,950 students in 2011 (Table 2). 9,343 students joined the PFIs, 4,600 students opted for private institutions/DE while 3,007 students pursued their higher studies overseas. A 10.7% drop of new admissions was recorded in the PFIs, from 10,459 in 2010 to 9,343 in 2011, with 3 institutions accounting for the decline, namely the MIE (-31.3%), the MGI (-5.6%) and the UTM (-4.2%). Concurrently, the number of students who went abroad fell from 3,500 to 3,007 over the same period, representing a decrease of 14.1%. In contrast, the number of students enrolled with a private institution or studying through the distance education mode increased by 10.4%, from 4,167 to 4,600 during the year. Some 54.7% (5,114) of the new intake in the PFIs were studying full-time, 32.8% (3,065) part-time and 12.5% (1,164) through the DE mode (Table 8). Likewise,

10.2% (957) of new entrants were doing a Masters and 49.3% a Degree (including Diploma/Degree), amongst others.

4.1 The University of Mauritius

Enrolment at the UoM, excluding those on joint programmes with the MIE, MGI and the UTM, grew by 8.5%, from 10,356 in 2010 to 11,239 in 2011. Some 73.4% of students (8,253) were studying full-time (Table 9). All the faculties registered positive growth as follows: Science: +11.9% (137), Engineering: +11.3 (338), Social Studies & Humanities: +9.9% (191), Law & Management: +5.2% (203), and the Faculty of Agriculture with +3.8% (14).

The Faculty of Law and Management remained the biggest Faculty with 4,133 students, followed by the Faculty of Engineering- 3,322 students, the Faculty of Social Studies & Humanities- 2,120 students, the Faculty of Science- 1,285 students and the Faculty of Agriculture- 379 students. During the year, three of these faculties increased their enrolment share, namely Engineering (from 28.8% to 29.6%), Science (from 11.1% to 11.4%) and Social Studies & Humanities (from 18.6% to 18.9%). The faculties of Law & Mgt and Agriculture on the other hand, registered a decline, from 37.9% to 36.8% and from 3.5% to 3.4% respectively.

A majority of UOM students were reading for a Degree (81.2%); the remaining were doing Masters or higher-level programmes (11.3 %), Diploma/Degree (2.4%), Diploma (5.0%) and Certificate (0.1%) programmes. The distribution of enrolment by faculty, programme, level and gender is shown at Table 10, while Table 11 gives enrolment by faculty, level and mode of study. Tables 12 to 19, on the other hand, shows enrolment in respect of each of the faculties by programme of study and gender, distinguishing between full-time and part-time, including those ran in collaboration with the MIE and the MGI.

In the academic year 2011/12, the UoM (excluding joint programmes) recruited 2,797 (72.4%) new students on a full-time basis, 847 (21.9%) on a part-time and 222 (5.7%) on Distance Education/ Mixed-mode, or a total of 3,866 compared to 3,648 in 2010 (Table 20). Female constituted 58.5% of the new intake which was distributed by level, as follows: Masters- 399 (10.3%); Degree- 3,052 (78.9%); Diploma/Degree- 154 (4%) and Diploma- 261 (6.8%) (Table 21).

4.2 The University of Technology, Mauritius

Enrolment at the UTM went up from 3,831 in 2010 to 4,370 in 2011, representing a growth rate of 14.1% over the year. Tables 22 to 28 give total enrolment at the UTM by mode, gender and level as well as by programme of study in respect of each of its three schools, namely the School of Business Management & Finance (SBMF), the School of Innovative Technologies and Engineering (SITE) and the School of Sustainable Development and Tourism (SSDT), while Tables 29 and 30 give new admissions distributed by school, mode, gender and level.

Some 2,352 students (53.8%) were enrolled in the School of Business Management & Finance, 1,077 (24.7%) in the School of Innovative Technologies and Engineering and 941 (21.5%) in the School of Sustainable Development and Tourism (Table 24). Some 773 (17.7%) students were reading for a Masters, 3,332 (76.3%) for a Degree; 132 (3.0%) for a Diploma; 92 for a Certificate (2.1%) and 41 (0.9%) for an MPhil/PhD. Overall, full-time (2,240) exceeded part-time (2,130) students. Similarly, male (2,343) surpassed female (2,027) students by some 316, constituting 53.6% of the student population.

A total of 1,736 new students were recruited in 2011 compared to 1,813 in 2010, of which 817 (47.1%) were part-time and 834 (48%) female (Tables 29 and 30).

4.3 The Mauritius Institute of Education

Enrolment at the MIE fell by 22.4%, from 5,032 in 2010 to 3,903 in 2011. Some 833 (21.3%) students were enrolled full-time, 2,026 (51.9%) part-time and 1,044 (26.8%) were studying through the distance education mode. Female made up for 75.7% (2,956) of the student population. Table 32 shows enrolment distribution at the MIE by programme, year of study and gender. Some 62 (1.6%) students were reading for a Masters, 541 (13.9%) for a Postgraduate Certificate/Diploma, 165 (4.2%) for a Degree, 2,137 (54.7%) for a Diploma and 998 (25.6%) for a Certificate.

The number of new admissions in 2011 stood at 2,261, of which 1,734 (76.7%) were female. Compared to 2010, this represented a shortfall of 1,031. Some 492 new intake were studying full-time, 1,068 part-time and 701 through the distance education mode; 1,538 students, on the other hand, were in their second year and 104 in their third year.

4.4 The Mahatma Gandhi Institute

Tertiary enrolment at the MGI (excluding joint MGI/RTI enrolment) amounted to 597 in 2011, representing an increase of 11.2 % over 2010, while new intake declined by 5.6% (from 233 to 220) over the same period (Table 33). Some 307 (51.4%) students were enrolled on a full-time basis and 290 (48.6%) on a part-time basis. Female comprised 81.7% of total enrolment.

The students were studying Languages and Indian Philosophy (374 or 62.7%), Fine/Digital Arts (113 or 18.9%), Performing Arts (95 or 15.9%) and Mauritian Studies (15 or 2.5%) at various levels as follows: 76 (12.7%) were on a Masters, 347 (58.1%) on a Degree including Degree/Diploma and 174 (29.2%) on a Diploma programme. The Masters and Degree programmes were run jointly with the UoM.

4.5 The Mauritius College of the Air

The MCA recruited 251 new students in 2011, bringing its total tertiary enrolment to 664, compared to 546 in 2010, or an increase of 21.6%. Female enrolment constituted 59.3% (394) of the total. Some 23 tertiary programmes were offered, of which twelve were run in collaboration with Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) of India, one each with IGNOU/SADC, and the University of Madras, and two each with the UoM, the Chartered Institute of Logistic & Transport (CILT), UK, the UTM and Amity University (Table 35).

The distribution of the student population by level was as follows: Masters- 221, Postgraduate Diploma- 20, Degree- 276 and Diploma- 147. The fields of study comprised Business Administration (124), Commerce (10), Computer Applications (3), Distance Education (13), English (281), Human Resource Management (14), Management (21), Risk Management (23), Transport (64), Journalism and Mass Communication (2), Library and Information Science (39) Youth and Development Work (19), Finance & Control (12), Finance & Investment Analysis (14) and HIV and Family Education (25).

4.6 The Swami Dayanand Institute of Management and the Institut Supérieur de Technologie

The student population in respect of the SDIM and the IST totaled 862 in 2011, representing an increase of 5.4% over 2010 (818). Some 700 (81.2%) students were studying on a full-time basis while 521 (60.4%) were in their first year.

Enrolment at the SDIM stood at 560 in 2011, compared to 602 in 2010, representing a decrease of 7.0%; the corresponding figures for the IST were 302 and 216 respectively, equivalent to an increase of 39.8%. The distribution of enrolment by programme and year of study in respect of each of the polytechnics are shown at Tables 36 and 37 respectively. As can be noted, the SDIM was running a total of 10 diploma-level and 2 Foundation programmes as opposed to seven for the IST.

4.7 The Mauritius Institute of Training and Development

The MITD had a total tertiary enrolment of 507 in 2011 compared to 465 in 2010, of which 239 constituted new admissions. Some twelve programmes were offered on a full-time basis. As shown in Table 38 which gives enrolment by mode, gender, programme and year of study, 210 students were studying for a Higher National Diploma (HND), 95 for a National Diploma and 202 for a Diploma. The student distribution by field was as follows: Tourism/Hospitality Management (249), Information Technology (38) and Engineering (135) and Culinary Arts (59) and Business Administration (26).

4.8 The Fashion & Design Institute

The FDI ran only three programmes in 2011 as compared to seven programmes in 2010 (Table 31). These included two HND programmes and a Diploma in Foundation programme in the fields Fashion and Textile (31), Information Technology (62) and Arts (59) respectively. A total of 152 students, including 83 female, were enrolled on these programmes on a full time basis.

4.9 The Rabindranath Tagore Institute

The RTI ran only one programme in 2011, namely a Part-time Diploma in Dramatic Arts, where 26 students were enrolled, including fourteen male and twelve female students (Table 34).

4.10 The Mauritius Institute of Health

The MIH ran seven programmes in 2011; four of which were dispensed on a full-time basis, namely a postgraduate specialisation in Anaesthesia, Internal Medicine and Ophthalmology respectively and a Diplome Universitaire VIH/Addictologie. The remaining three part-time programmes related to a Certificate in Dental Assisting, a National Certificate for the Care of the Elderly and Disabled and a Surgical Operating Theatre Technician course. A total of 122 students, including 41 male and 81 female, were enrolled on these programmes (Table 39).

4.11 Private

The number of students pursuing tertiary education in the private Post-Secondary Educational Institutions (PSEIs) or directly with an institution overseas through the distance mode totaled 13,464 in 2011 compared to 11,661 in 2010, representing an increase of 15.5%.

Tables 40 and 41 give examinations statistics from both MES (8,242) and Non-MES sources (3,419) respectively; these statistics are used as proxy indicators for gauging enrolment in private institutions as well as those studying through the distance mode. In 2011, examinations were held in respect of 76 awarding bodies, including 72 overseas and 4 local; the overseas awarding bodies were based in the UK (42), France/ Reunion (9), India (6), Australia (6), South Africa (3), Malaysia (2), USA (2) and Sudan (2). Overall, 6,300 (46.8%) students were examined in a Professional programme, 4,322 (32.1%) in a Degree (including a Diploma/ Degree), 1,303 (9.7%) in a Diploma, 1,003 (7.4%) in a Masters, 328 (2.4%) in a Certificate, 115 (0.9%) in a Foundation course, 57 (0.4%) in a Postgraduate Diploma and 36 in a PhD (0.3%) programme. The enrolment distribution by field is at Table 42.

A survey was carried out in respect of the 58 PSEIs registered with the TEC as at December 2011: 15 institutions were not operational while of the 43 remaining which were running programmes; 41 provided the necessary data. Total enrolment in these institutions worked out at 9,613 with student population ranging from 19 to 1,793 students (Table 43). Female outnumbered male students constituting 52.5% of the total (5,045 female compared to 4,568 male). Table 45 gives the distribution of enrolment in the PSEIs by field of study and gender as well as by level, mode of study and gender, respectively. Some 3,840 (40.0%) students were enrolled full-time, 5,202 (54.1%) part-time and 571 (5.9%) through the distance education mode. Amongst the most popular fields of study were Accountancy with 3,372 (35.1%) students, followed by Administration/Management-1,919 (20%), Business/Commerce/ Marketing- 1,218 (12.7%), Information Technology- 678 (7%), Medicine with 640 (6.7%) students, Others with 233 (2.4%), Engineering with 224 (2.3%) students, Law with 204 (2.1%), Languages with 194 (2.0%) students and Communication with 182 (1.9%) students (Table 47).

A total of 3,851 private students were following distance education programmes directly with an institution overseas in 2011, without going through an intermediary locally. From Table 47, it can be noted that these students were enrolled in the fields of Accounting (42.7%), Information Technology (12.0%), Law (7.5%), Arts (9.8%) and Banking/Finance (9.1%).

The overall number of students pursuing tertiary education through distance education in the country is shown at Table 48, by source and broad field of study. In addition to the 3,851 private students above, some 2,214 students were studying through the PFIs and 571 through the PSEIs, giving a total of 6,626 distance education students. Accounting was the most popular discipline amongst the distance learners with 1,644 (24.8%) students followed by Education- 1,183 (17.8%), Administration/Management- 987 (14.9%), Information Technology- 485 (7.3%) Banking/Finance- 474 (7.1%), Law - 405 (6.1%) and Arts- 378 (5.7%).

Table 49 gives enrolment through the distance education mode in the PFIs. As can be noted, three institutions were running a total of 32 programmes, distributed as follows: UoM- 9; MCA- 21; and MIE- 2, with student cohorts of 530, 640 and 1,044 respectively or a total of 2,214. Some 234 (10.6%) students were reading for a Masters, 20 (0.9%) for a Postgraduate Diploma, 616 (27.8%) for a Degree and 1,344 (60.7%) for a Diploma.

4.12 Foreign Students Studying in Mauritius

Some 635 foreign students, including 397 male and 238 female, were studying in Mauritius in 2011, compared to 596 in 2010, representing a growth rate of 6.5%. Some 590 (92.9%) students were enrolled on full-time programmes. The foreign students were concentrated in 22 institutions: 4 PFIs (81 students), 17 private PSEIs (492 students) and a regional institution namely the IFE (62). Their distribution by institution, mode and gender is shown at Table 50 while Table 51 gives enrolment details by programme of study. The distribution of the foreign students by country of origin, on the other hand, is at Table 52. As can be noted, the students originated from 48 countries, including, amongst others, India (188), Madagascar (85), Nigeria (71), South Africa (61), Seychelles (27), France (27), Reunion (25), Comoros (24), Kenya (16), Germany (13), Uganda (9) and Zimbabwe (8).

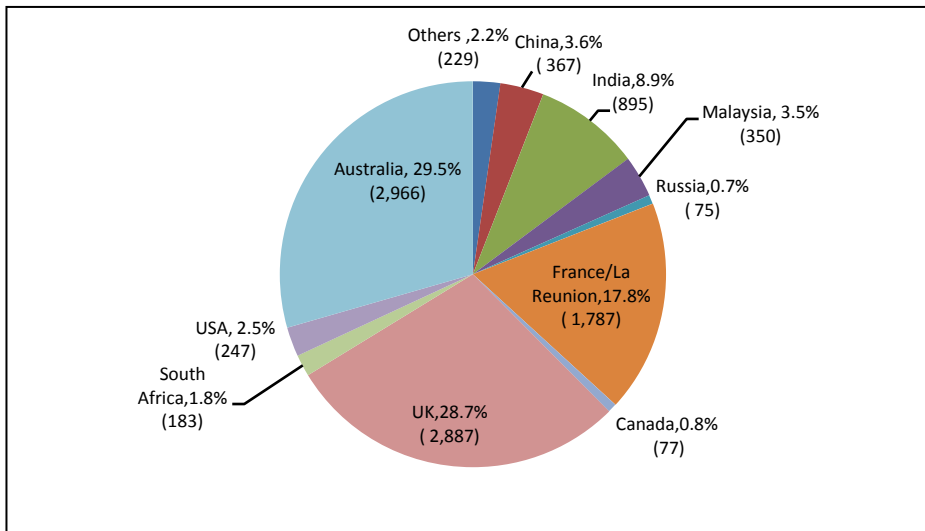
4.13 Mauritian Students Studying Abroad

In 2011, some 3,007 Mauritian students pursued higher studies overseas, as opposed to 3,500 in 2010. Table 53 gives the distribution of the students by country of destination and field of study in 2011. Australia (from 1,555 in 2010 to 1,234 in 2011) and the UK (from 850 to 643) were the most affected destinations. The number of newly admitted Mauritian students studying in other

countries such as the Canada, China, France/Reunion and India has, on the other hand, increased from 22 to 32, 94 to 98, 350 to 372 and 262 to 394 respectively over the same period.

Overall, total number of Mauritian students studying overseas decreased by 7.7%, from 10,907 in 2010 to 10,063 in 2011. Australia remained, nonetheless, the most popular destination amongst Mauritian students, with a total enrolment of 2,966 or 29.5% of the student population overseas. The UK came second with total enrolment of 2,887 (28.7%), followed by France/Reunion (1,787 or 17.8%) and India (895 or 8.9%). The figure below gives further details concerning the distribution of overseas enrolment by destination.

Some 45.2% of overseas enrolment was in a Science & Technology related field: 1,456 (14.5%) students opted for Engineering; 1,294 (12.9%) for Medicine; 506 (5.0%) for Information Technology; 443 (4.4%) for Natural Sciences; 239 (2.4%) for Architecture; 194 (1.9%) for Mathematics; 140 (1.4%) for Dentistry; 109 (1.1%) for Health Sciences, 99 (1.0%) for Pharmacy; 40 (0.4%) for Textile and 32 (0.3%) for Agriculture. Some 853 (8.5%) students, in parallel, were doing Business/Commerce/Marketing; 714 (7.1%) Administration/Management; 579 (5.8%) Law; 467 (4.6%) Social Science; 377 (3.7%) Humanities; 364 (3.6%) Travel/Hotel/Tourism; 361 (3.6%) Economics; 229 (2.3%) Languages; 220 (2.2%)

Banking/Finance; 175 (1.7%) Communication; 126 (1.3%) Arts; 97 (1.0%) Education, 96 (1.0%)
Psychology and 18 (0.2%) Religious Studies.

DEFINITION OF TERTIARY EDUCATION AND TERTIARY EDUCATION ENROLMENT RATE

According to UNESCO, the Gross Enrolment Rate at the tertiary level (GTER) is defined as the number of students enrolled in tertiary education (ISCED level 5 and 6), regardless of age, expressed as a percentage of the population in the theoretical age group for that level of education, that is the five-year age group following official secondary school graduation age (taken in our case as 20 to 24 years)

$$\text{i.e., GTER} = (\text{Enrolment in Tertiary Education} / \text{population aged 20-24 years}) * 100$$

UNESCO defines tertiary education to include universities, teachers' colleges, and higher professional schools, requiring as a minimum condition of admission the successful completion of education at the secondary level, or evidence of the attainment of an equivalent level of knowledge. TEC's definition of tertiary education aligns itself with that of UNESCO and encompasses all post-HSC/ A Level or equivalent programmes leading, upon completion to the award of either a Certificate- 1 full academic year; or a Diploma- 2 full academic year; or a Degree- 3 full academic year; or Postgraduate Degree or any other qualification recognized by the TEC.

However, the computation of GTER by UNESCO and TEC differs, as follows:

- For UNESCO, *the number of students enrolled in tertiary education* includes all students, local and international, enrolled and based locally and excludes all local students studying overseas
- For TEC, on the other hand, *the number of students enrolled in tertiary education* refers to Mauritian students only, irrespective of whether they are studying locally or overseas.

As a result, our GTER reflects the participation rate of the local population in tertiary education as opposed to that of UNESCO which gauges the local supply capacity with regard to tertiary education.

Our GTER for 2011, accordingly, works out at 45%, as follows:

$$\text{GTER} = (\text{Total Enrolment} \textit{ minus Foreign students} \textit{ divided by} \textit{ (Population aged 20-24 yr)} \\ \textit{ multiply by 100}$$

$$= (45969 - 635 / 100,769) * 100 = 45,334 / 100,769 * 100 = 45\%$$

The attention of users is drawn to the fact that the GTER and not the Net Tertiary enrolment Rate (NTER) is the most widely adopted indicator internationally, for obvious practical reasons. The GTER refers to the number of students enrolled at the tertiary level, whether or not they belong to

the relevant age group for that level. The NTER, on the other hand, is the number of students enrolled at the tertiary level who belong in the relevant age group as a percentage of the population in that age group.
